Unclaimed 2025 Power Dividend: Consumers Urged to Register

12 February 2026

There are still a number of eligible Napier and Hastings power account holders yet to register for the 2025 Hawke's Bay Power Consumers' Trust dividend payment of \$270.

On Thursday, 12 February, we will be sending out a final email reminder to these power consumers encouraging them to register at www.hbpct.co.nz/dividend-information. All power consumers in Hawke's Bay who were connected to Unison Networks Limited (UNL) on 30 September 2025 are eligible to receive the payment.

HBPCT Chair, Kirsten Westwood says "While it's fantastic that around 95 percent of eligible power consumers have received their 2025 dividend, we want to ensure as many people as possible receive this payment. If you haven't yet registered, or if your bank account or address details have changed from the previous year, you will need to register your correct information to receive payment."

"We also ask that you please check with your whānau and friends to make sure that they have registered, and to help them with the registration process. We don't want anyone to miss out on the \$270 they are entitled to," said Ms Westwood.

Every eligible power account holder will have received their unique 6-digit code. To register for direct credit, consumers will need their:

- Unique 6-digit code (sent by email, text or post)
- ICP Number (found on your power bill)
- Bank account details
